Soda Tab

Client sets a dollar amount and the tab is open until it reaches the amount. Soda tabs may include Soda (Pepsi Products), Juices, Kiddie Cocktails, and/or Sprecher's Bottled Root Beer.

Open Bar Tab

Client sets a dollar amount or a time frame; the tab is open until it reaches the amount or until the specified time. Client is able to place the following restrictions on an Open Bar Tab should they wish: No shots, No Specific Liquor (up to two), No Doubles, No Can Beer.

Reserve Kegs

Client is responsible for payment of all barrels ordered whether they are consumed or not, as DVL is unable to return unused barrels to our suppliers. We do allow a maximum of 1 Miller Lite & 2 Bud Light Barrels to be put on reserve in the event that all barrels ordered are used and additional are needed. Reserve barrels must be requested prior to event. Client may choose to verbally authorize tapping of each reserve barrel or choose a time the barrels may be tapped until.

Alcoholic Beverages

Clients and clients' guests may not bring alcoholic beverages into DVL or onto Banquet Grounds, even during hours when the bar is not operational. Private bars may be closed earlier than originally requested per management discretion. DVL reserves the rights to not serve to intoxicated parties. Please note that State and Local Liquor Laws regulate alcoholic beverage sales and services.
